#### [Continuation of last week's sermon summary]

Do not be afraid to come down from on high. He wants to be best friends with you, even if you don't stretch yourself or be respectable. At this time, Zacchaeus's senses and whole body were focused on Christ, not on this world. This is called conversion. Conversion is not about repenting of our mistakes, but about turning our whole body (life) to Christ.

**3** Starting a Christ-centered life His encounter with Jesus filled him. Zacchaeus's life changed 180 degrees. He later became a disciple of Peter and the bishop of Caesarea. Jesus says: "Salvation came to this house today, for he is also the son of Abraham. For the Son of Man has come to seek and save the lost." (Verses 9~10) The purpose of Christ's coming to this earth was to "search for the lost." "Lost" means that something has moved away from where it should have been, and has been placed in the wrong place. Man was created to be placed on God's side. Therefore, our lives must change to a God-centered life, a Christ-centered life. To change our lives, to change from world-centered to kingdom-centered, to die in this world and live in the kingdom of God, to abandon the values of this world and change to the values of Christ. That is why we were created anew by Christ. It is said that "those who are involved in the affairs of the world should be like those who have nothing to do with them" (1 Corinthians 7:31), but unfortunately Christians today are only enthusiastic about the problems of this world. Because we are not dead in this world, we are not living in the kingdom of God. That's why we argue and judge each other about the things of this world. Remember, Christ brought you out of this world and gathered you to heaven. And I would like you to use the time you have left to learn to live in heaven.
