### [Continuation of last week's sermon summary]

Sin is very much like that. They feel guilty, but not enough to cure them. So what is treatment? It is to run to Christ, the physician of the soul, and pray desperately for His help. It is called sin to think that you can manage yourself without praying to Christ. On the first day of Lent, I realized that I was a very seriously ill person, but I had neglected treatment. Said the old monk. People who say that they are busy with their own treatment do not have time to judge others.

(If this cup does not pass away unless I drink) The second time Jesus prayed, "If this cup does not pass away unless I drink." "Father, if this cup does not pass away unless I drink" (verse 42). I stopped at the words, "If this cup does not pass away unless I drink." Here we see Jesus' decision to cross the cross. Prayer is to receive the power to make decisions from God. and to be hungry. Decisions made in prayer cannot be overshadowed by a little interference, criticism, or sweet temptation. The face of the person who makes the decision changes and becomes stronger. From this point on, Jesus will be silent. Isaiah prophesies brilliantly. "Every morning I awaken my ears and make them listen and obey as disciples. I did not rebel, I did not retreat. Whoever tried to hit him had his back. Without hiding his face, he received ridicule and spit. ... I will make my face like a hard stone." (Isaiah 50:4~7) The outcome will be decided in this praver.

Are you making the decision to obey God? A monk asked an old master. "Why can't you be a saint?" The old master says. "It's because of weak decision-making!" Decision literally means to cut off your thoughts and decide to live in God. Prayer will strengthen us and give us God's radiance, authority, and power. Let's pray constantly.
