[Continuation of last week's sermon summary]

 $^{\searrow}$ descendants will be as numerous as the grains of sand... All the nations of the earth will be blessed through you and your descendants." (28:13-14)

This is the same blessing given to his grandfather Abraham. For he will be the one to inherit Abraham's blessing. Furthermore, "Behold, I am with you. Wherever you go, I will protect you and bring you back to this land. I will not leave vou until I have done what I have promised you." (28:15) He realized that although he had sinned and been driven from his family home, God welcomed him into His own house. Though the door to his family home was closed, the door to God's house stood open, warmly receiving him. Normally, Jacob, who had committed the grave sin against God of deceiving his father and brother to steal the blessing, should not have been blessed. Yet God blesses such a Jacob. This teaches us that blessing is something given unilaterally by God's mercy, unrelated to human righteousness or sinfulness. It also teaches us that blessing is something humans cannot obtain no matter how much they use schemes or strength.

This stairway connecting heaven and earth was a prototype of Jesus Christ. Jesus said, "You will see greater things than these. ...you will see heaven open and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man." (John 1:51) He alone is the stairway to heaven, for He alone came from heaven to earth. Through this Christ, every blessing descends upon us, and through Christ, we draw near to God. The church still stands as the stairway to heaven, welcoming all sinners as God's house and bestowing blessings.
