# [Continuation of last week's sermon summary]

So Moses got up early in the morning and went up to Mount Sinai as the Lord had commanded him. Then "the Lord descended in the cloud and stood there with Moses, proclaiming the name of the Lord." (34:5). Mount Sinai is a very steep and rocky mountain, and it takes about two hours to reach the summit, so Moses must have gotten up at about 4:00 in the morning to go up there. We, like Moses, must be prepared to meet God. In other words, we must climb the mountain of God in prayer. No one can see the Lord apart from a holy life." (Heb. 12:14). Only those who live a life of prayer can see God.

There was a pastor in London named George Muller. He was known as the father of orphans, and Juji Ishii, who devoted his life to orphans in Japan, was a man who followed his way of life. Muller nourished thousands of orphans with his prayers. The scripture he constantly spoke was, "I will never leave you, and I will never forsake you" (Heb. 13:4). (Heb. 13:4). He prayed to the point of sickness. He prayed, but God never gave until he was just about there. But it was never too late, never too much, and when he prayed for this much money, it was given to him. God promised to be with people. But people must also make an effort to be with God. We want to firmly remember that without faith we cannot be pleasing to God, and we cannot see God without holy living.
