[Continuation of last week's sermon summary]

√For 38 years, Jesus asked the man who had been lying sick by the Pool of Bethesda, "Do you want to get well?" It's the same thing.

There is a woman named 0 who attends our Heartwarming Gatherings. She is scheduled to be baptized soon, and I am always impressed by the words that come from her mouth. Her husband had a mental illness but refused to seek medical help. He subjected the family to constant suffering through violence and verbal abuse. Her husband eventually passed away. Afterwards, she began studying mental illness and came to believe she herself was at fault. It's clear she is trying to find meaning in her painful experiences, never blaming others, and striving earnestly to change herself. Such a person is refreshing to see and encourages those around them. She has also given courage to those leaving cult religions to be baptized and become Christians. Those who strive to change are beautiful, and God's Spirit works within them. That is why they bear fruit. What, then, is the preparation to welcome Christ the Savior? What is repentance? It is not merely a worldly moral matter of stopping bad deeds. If one could simply stop, the cross of God's Son would be unnecessary. Repentance is acknowledging one's own powerlessness and having a heart that needs the Savior. It is a broken and contrite spirit that knows it must change and needs to change. Such a heart is the preparation most pleasing to God. During this Advent season, let us earnestly desire, "I want to change," "I want to become better," and keep praying for it.
