【Continuation of last week's sermon summary】

They worshiped Jesus and opened their treasure chests to present gold, frankincense, and myrrh. Gold is offered to kings, frankincense to God, and myrrh to the dead. This teaches us that Jesus is King, God, and the One who came to die. But Jesus did not need myrrh, for His body did not decay but rose again. These three gifts seem to reveal not only who Jesus is, but also what we ourselves must offer. We desire to offer gold as a confession that we live by God, not by money; frankincense as prayer; and myrrh as thanksgiving that we too will receive imperishable bodies. Following the warning in a dream not to return to Herod, they ignored his command and departed for their own country by another route. The phrase “another route” teaches us that their way of life had been renewed. As long as we live by our own strength, we cannot shine. But when we lose ourselves and can only live by God, God's life enters us and we shine. The astrologers feel very free. They do not fear Herod. They freely relinquish the treasures of this world—gold, frankincense, and myrrh. And upon encountering the star that guides them and Christ, they overflow with joy. Those who serve false earthly kings are ruled by fear and anxiety, but how radiant are those who live with heaven as their goal! We too wish to walk this path of joy and freedom.
